REPORTS BY STAFF

Commander Alvizo advised the board that there is currently 1 graduate from the Police Academy and the hiring process has opened for 3 additional lateral level officers.

CSO Aguil tells the board about the turn out for the Holiday Safety Fair in December and the Christmas Cookie donation to the Senior Center.

Board Member Morrison told the board about the abandoned home next to his and the people who enter and exit the residence.


Board Member Hylton appreciates the officers that enforce the speed limit on 9th Avenue.
