CALL TO ORDER

Chair Stephens called the meeting to order at 6:05 pm.

ROLL CALL

Board Members present were Stephens, Moore, Hylton, Gutierrez, and Flores. Board Members absent were Villaruz, Morrison, Perigo, and Lane.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETINGS

A motion was made by Board Member Flores and seconded by Board Member Moore. 5 Ayes, 0 abstentions, 4 Absent.

COMMENTS BY CITIZENS

Cornell Markham, 2110 Patton Street. Mr. Markham asked for a Citizen Complaint Form and the date for the next Community Law Enforcement Liaison Board meeting so that he may attend again.

REGULAR AGENDA

Chief DeRosia explains to the board the ordinance for the Community Law Enforcement Liaison board, Chapter 2.64 and the new changes. Chief DeRosia explains the difference made from the current ordinance and the proposed ordinance.

Board Member Flores makes a motion to accept the proposed ordinance for the Community Law Enforcement Liaison Board (Chapter 2.64), seconded by Board Member Hylton. 5 Ayes, 0 abstentions, 4 Absent.

Chief DeRosia explains to the board that he wanted to discuss some of the goals that the board created. He explains to the board the cost of putting a column in the Delano Record versus putting an article in the Delano Now online newspaper.

REPORTS BY STAFF

Chief DeRosia explains the surveys that were given out at the last Delano Police Department event. He tells the board that on the reverse side of the survey that there were questions pertaining to the Community Law Enforcement Liaison Board and letting the public know about the CLELB meetings.

Chief DeRosia also tells the board that he will be visiting the architects in Sacramento. He also tells the board that the new police facility is on track and that the ground breaking will be in December of 2011. He also tells the board that there are 2 officers currently serving in Iraq and that the police department has openings

CSO Aguil invites the CLELB to National Night Out on August 2nd. He also invites the board to have a booth so that they can get information to the public about the CLELB.

CSO Fowler invites the CLELB to the Crime Prevention Anti-Violence fair on May 21st at Cecil Avenue Park. He also informs the board that there will lots of information and entertainment as well as a bike rodeo, child fingerprinting and safety videos.
