

Appeal Notice: Any person aggrieved by the decision of the Planning Commission may appeal the decision within ten (10) calendar days to the City Council. Any person may appeal a decision of the Planning Commission to the City Council where the Planning Commission's decision would otherwise be final. Appeal application forms are available at the office of the Community Development Department to all persons wishing to appeal an action included in this Title. Appeal applications shall be filed with the Community Development Department within ten (10) calendar days following the date of action for which an appeal is made unless otherwise provided. If the last day to file falls on a holiday or on a Saturday or Sunday, the following business day shall be deemed the last day to act. Appeals shall be forwarded to the City Clerk by the Community Development Director. *Effective Date of Appealed Actions.* Except as otherwise provided for in this Title, an action that has been appealed shall not become effective until a final determination is made by the appropriate decision making body.
