Highlights:

On 12/18/18, we conducted a Street Interdiction Team (SIT) operation. This operation consisted of 53 Law Enforcement Officers from several agencies such as Kern County Probation, Ridgecrest PD, Kern County Sheriffs, Bakersfield PD, Taft PD, CDCR and Tulare Auto Theft Task Force. During this operation, approximately 54 searches were conducted, which resulted in 18 arrests for various violations. Additionally, 16 non-planned searches were conducted as a result of investigations conducted during this operation. Seized items consisted of (1) AR-15 rifle with ammunition, (1) handgun, (24) ounces of Methamphetamine, scales, evidence of narcotic sales, and other prohibited items.
