Areas of Focus:

Standardized Field Sobriety Test Training

A member of the Traffic Unit attended a 16 hour SFST course. The course is a comprehensive course that is designed to increase the officer's ability to detect impairment in drivers. The

fundamental purpose of the training is to foster DWI deterrence, i.e., to dissuade people from driving while impaired by increasing the odds that they will be arrested and convicted.

Speed/Message Trailer:

374 Days Free of a Traffic Fatality (05/06/2019):

The Delano Police Department would like to thank its motorists and pedestrians alike for utilizing safe practices while traveling along roadways. Within the incorporated city limits of Delano, there has not been a fatality resulting from a collision, since April 27, 2018. The Delano Police Department investigates on average three to four collisions a year resulting in fatalities.

Special Operations:

Tentative DUI/Driver’s License Checkpoint scheduled for June 2019. Checkpoint in correspondence with local high school graduations in an attempt to educate and deter drivers from driving while intoxicated.
